<b>No Contracts to Sign</b>	<b>Yes</b>  Month-to-month agreements, no annual commitment.	<b>No</b>  Yearly commitments and early termination fees.
<b>Fully customizable mobile device policies</b>	<b>Yes</b>  BlackBerry Enterprise Server and ActiveSync for iPhone and Windows Mobile devices are available. We do not require that you purchase the BlackBerry license, it’s included, and IBSPoint helps you set up the service and provides support for it.	<b>No</b>  Only support for BES functionality. Customer needs to bring their own BES licenses and include MS in their support agreement.
